HISTORY OF ICE POPS

Summer Reading Comprehension


Did you know that the ice pop was invented by an 11-year-old boy? In 1905 Frank Epperson accidentally left a glass of water, powdered soda mix and a wooden stick for stirring—outside overnight.

When he went outside the next morning, the water mixture had frozen so he ran it under warm water and the ice pop came out of the glass, using the stick as a handle. Frank began to make his ice pop creations for his friends and later his own children.

In 1923, he filed for a patent for his "frozen ice on a stick" invention. A patent is a document that gives the inventor the right to exclude others from making their invention for a certain time period. He at first called them "Eppsicles" but then later changed the name to Popsicle. What started off as an accident, became a great invention!




